BOOKINGS & FEES

- Spring bookings can be made at the Horsham Aquatic Centre from 26th August 2019.
- An enrolment form and routine outing form must be completed prior to making a booking for your child. These only need to be done annually.
- All forms can be collected at the Centre or downloaded from our website. Please fill in necessary forms and leave with staff at Reception. Your booking will be processed within 5 working days.
- Forms cannot be emailed, scanned or faxed to the centre. The booking form must be returned in person.
- Management reserves the right to cancel a child's enrolment if their behaviour is deemed unacceptable. Parents will be notified prior to a cancellation of enrolment.
- Daily fee cost \$77.14 per child per day. This can be reduced by claiming the Child Care Subsidy (CCS).
- To claim CCS you must register with Family Assistance Office (FAO) either call **13 61 50** or apply online www.familyassist.gov.au
- Bookings close on September 13th 2019. All bookings received after this date incur a \$20 administration fee.
- All payments are expected prior to commencement of the Program.
- Account discrepancies sometimes occur, as our software provider can only estimate the amount owing. Final accounts will be emailed at the end of the program.
